

Bone Pain

- Bone Pain may occur for many reasons.
 1. Neulasta and neupogen shots are sometimes given after chemo to stimulate white cells to grow in the bone marrow, this may cause bone pain.
 2. You may take Advil for the bone pain unless you are not able to take Advil, then use Tylenol.
 3. Certain chemo drugs, Zometa & Xgeva may also cause bone discomfort.
 4. If you have bone pain from cancer metastasis in the bones, you will need to discuss pain management (pain medicines) with your doctor or the nurses, when you are in for a visit.
