

Fever

1. Low grade fevers may occur after certain chemo or from certain cancers. It is not necessary to call the office with temperatures of 98.6 – 100.9.
2. Temperatures of 101 degrees or over require a call to the office: 732-367-1535 (After hours call 732-367-5878). If you experience symptoms of chills, aches or dry mouth, take your temperature.
3. Always drink plenty of fluids with any fever.
4. You may take Tylenol for chronic low grade temperatures, if this has been okayed by the physician.
